Thanks to a collaborative work, SUSTAIN E+ partners developed a training course divided into 9 main modules:

- EU projects and Sustainable Development Goals
- Sustainable project proposals
- Working procedures
- Digital management
- Energy and water efficiency
- Transport and mobility
- Transnational meetings onsite behaviours
- Food sustainability in EU projects
- Circular economy



Those main topics have been designed after having identified the major sources of impact in an EU project. They thus cover the main needs of an EU worker for the design, management, and technical implementation of an EU project. Thanks to this course, you will, for instance, learn how to optimise better transport while having to participate in mobility activities or reduce your consumption of material (paper, but also gigabytes) while working. It will help you raise awareness of the need to reduce our impact, but also provide you with practical recommendations for a direct application.





The different modules created by our consortium were tested in June and July 2023 by 107 EU projects' professionals. Over 96% of participants in the pilot activity were satisfied with the course proposal. Over 93% of them think that it achieves to train professionals in bettering their working practices, and nearly 80% think that it is exhaustive in answering the training need. Thanks to their valuable feedback, a few adjustments were made to finalise the modules, which will now be soon implemented in our project platform.
